### Volunteer Opportunities for 2017

At the start of each year we post a list of needed volunteers for projects in the upcoming year. At January's annual club reception, Hilary mentioned the following opportunities for those who'd like to donate some of their time to keep the club's activities running. The following tasks have been handled by just a few board members over the past several years, who will be stepping back from many of these responsibilities. Without new volunteers taking on long-term ownership of some of these positions, the MBBC will probably be cutting back on some of our projects and activities.

**Newsletter Editor:** This is Jennifer's 10th year as MBBC newsletter editor. And this will be her last year so it's time to pass the torch. Anyone who would like to learn a lot about publishing, journalism, and local bicycle goings-on in the city and state can ramp up this year and work with Jennifer on this year's newsletters with the goal of being ready to go solo starting in 2018. The job takes about 8-10 hours/month of communications and authoring/editing content, and about 6 additional hours laying out and formatting the 8-page publication. Requires a computer and desktop publishing software. Newsletter is currently done in Adobe InDesign and this is a great way to learn the software. Image manipulation with software such as Photoshop or ImageMagick is also required.

**Ride Leaders:** The club always needs more leaders for the different Tuesday and Wednesday groups. If you haven't had ride leader training, we can provide the materials and have an informal meeting to answer questions. We especially need more "casually-paced" ride leaders willing to lead the 10-12 and 12-14 mph groups on Tuesdays.

**Bike to Work/School Day Station Coordinator**: Manage the club's "Celebration Station" on Bike Day in May, including hauling tables and banners and treats, set up, take down, signs, cowbells, and enlist other volunteers to help at the station. Take responsibility for contacting sponsors to donate treats and prizes, and pick up and return serving items. We have a list of local businesses who have been sponsors in the past and the new coordinator can start by requesting help from them.

**Volunteer Coordinator:** The MBBC participates in a number of community events each year: Bike Show table, Rec NW Expo table, table at Community Co-Op summer picnic, table at Pickford film center, table at Chuckanut Radio Hour, Bellingham Marathon lead-out riders, occasional sports and recreation fairs at local companies. The club is also often invited to send a representative to meetings, for example on bike route planning or bike theft programs. We need a person to take these requests and coordinate volunteers to go to the different events. It can be done in a few hours per month but requires a good communicator to stay on top of the email requests and followup.

**Ride Leader Coordinator:** maintain contacts list of the MBBC's ride leaders, and ensure that enough leaders are signed up for every weekly ride throughout spring and summer - especially Tuesday rides which require multiple leaders of different speeds.
